Resolution No. 12-2018**

Resolution in support of 911 Surcharge Increase

WHEREAS, Muskegon County will have on the November 6, 2018 ballot, a proposal for a 9-1-1 Surcharge.

WHEREAS, the proposal is for the exclusive purpose of funding for Muskegon Central Dispatch 9-1-1.


WHEREAS, the funding will be used for operational, technology and maintenance requirements. Including emergency communication infrastructure, mobile computers, and wireless redundancy.

WHEREAS, Muskegon County shall be authorized to assess a monthly surcharge of up to \$2.75 (current collection is \$0.42), on all devices capable of accessing 9-1-1, on the service suppliers' monthly billings to service users within Muskegon County beginning July 1, 2019 and continuing until the repeal of MCL 484.1401 (currently scheduled for December 31, 2021).

NOW, THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED, that Cedar Creek Township Board of Trustees does support the 9-1-1 Surcharge Increase to improve the technology and maintenance requirements of our Muskegon Central Dispatch.
