## A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT OF THE MUSKEGON CENTRAL DISPATCH 9-1-1 SURCHARGE

<u>WHEREAS</u>, Muskegon Central Dispatch 9-1-1 receives a monthly surcharge on all devices that can access 9-1-1 for funding emergency dispatch operations, and

WHEREAS, the current 9-1-1 monthly surcharge of \$0.42 is one of the lowest in the state, and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the current funding of 9-1-1 can no longer keep pace with the operational demands of technology, increased call volumes and Next Generation 9-1-1 requirements, and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the 9-1-1 dispatch center and public safety agencies operate on radio components that are aging and experiencing failures, and by year's end will be difficult to service or repair,

<u>WHEREAS</u>, Muskegon Central Dispatch 9-1-1 proposes a monthly surcharge increase up to \$2.75 per month on all devices that can access 9-1-1 for funding emergency dispatch operations, and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, Dalton Township realizes the importance of the Muskegon Central Dispatch 9-1-1 system and is in favor of replacing or upgrading essential radio infrastructure and other components essential in maintaining the quality of service to Muskegon County citizens, and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, Dalton Township supports the proposed increase to the current 9-1-1 surcharge up to \$2.75 per month.
